



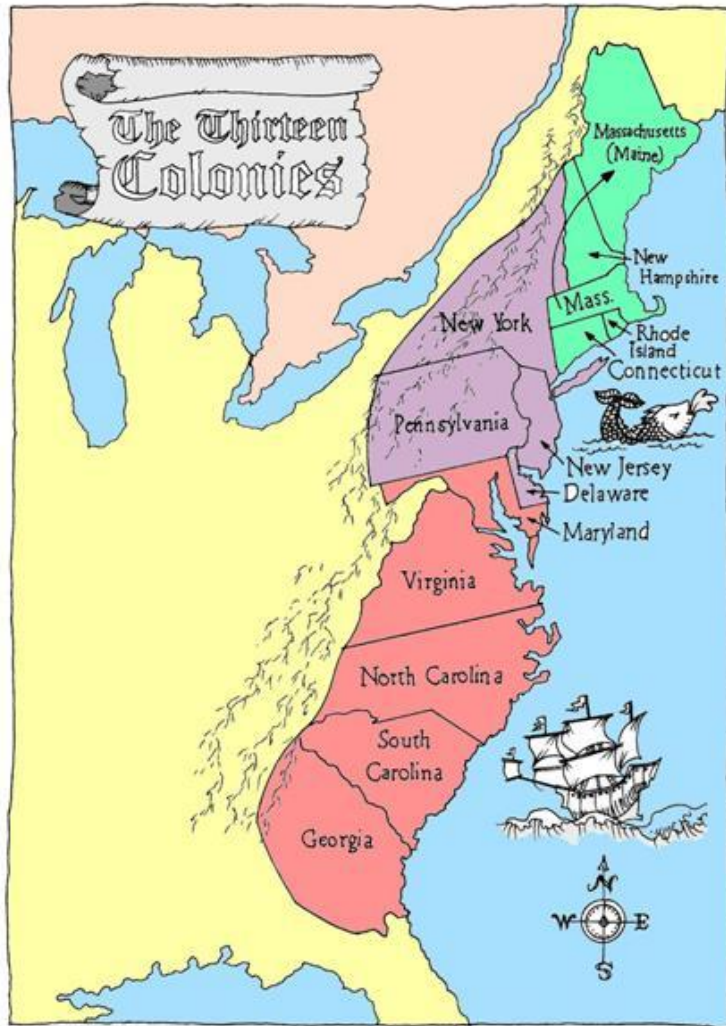

England created colonies in the Americas for a few reasons:

use the colonies as a stopping point between other trade locations.

They wanted to “spread out” and control more parts of the world.

- In **1584**, Queen Elizabeth sent Sir Walter Raleigh to set up England's first colony in North America.





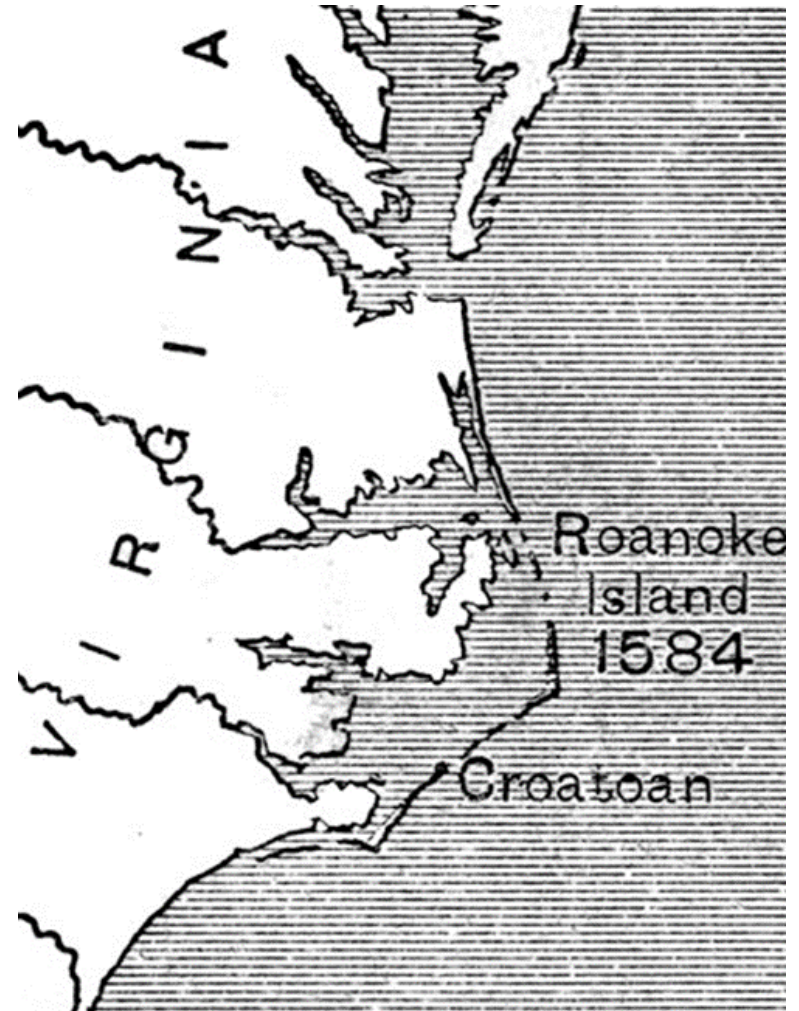
Roanoke Island



- Sir Walter Raleigh appointed John White to be the leader of the second group sent to Roanoke Island

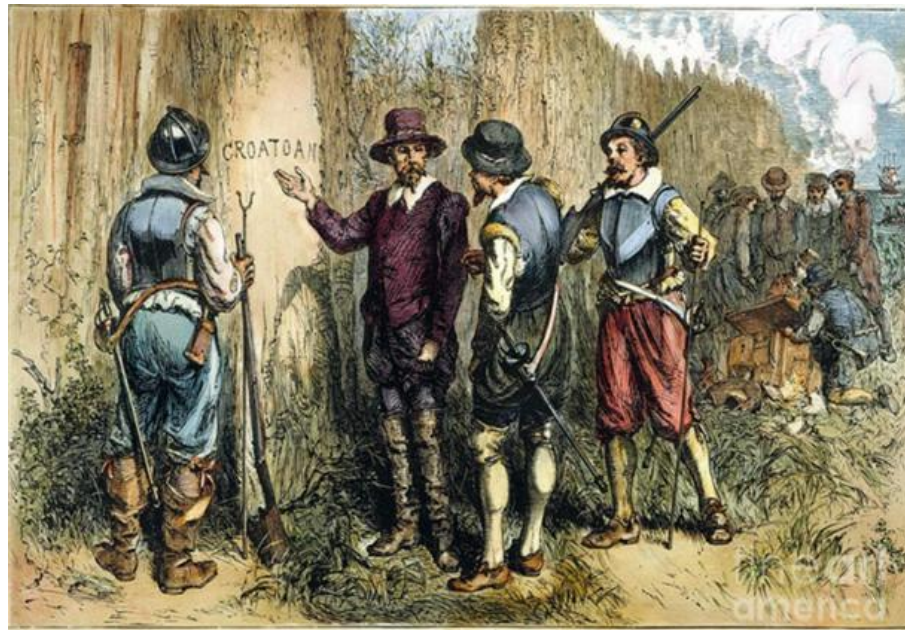
Three Years Later
