- Very traditional values

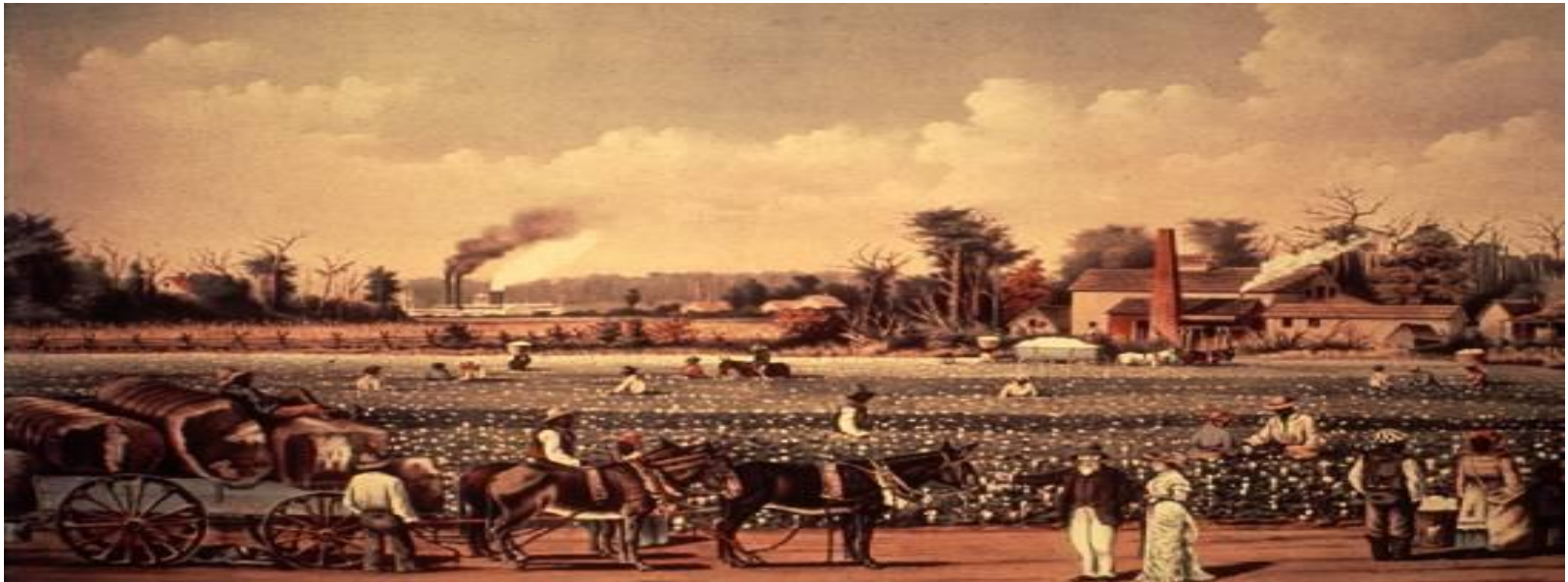


Tobacco Plants = “cash crop”
