


The Run-Down

- It happened on October 19, 1781.
- Yorktown is located on a peninsula between the York River and James River in Virginia.
- The French Navy blocked Yorktown harbor, so the British ships could not leave and were trapped.
- British General Cornwallis fought the Battle of Yorktown for three weeks before he finally surrendered to Washington and Lafayette.
- The Battle of Yorktown was the last <u>big battle</u> of the American Revolution.
- The American Revolution continued for another 2 years, but not a lot of fighting occurred.
- The Americans had won their independence and won the war.

Reasons Why America

Won

 (4) reasons why the
 Americans won the war:

#1: Geography

 The Americans knew the area better than the British. The British forces had to wait a long time for new supplies from England.

#2: Patriotic Spirit


 As the Americans started winning more battles, more Americans started to desire independence from England more and more.

#3: Skilled Leadership

 George Washington, and other officers serving under his leadership, learned from earlier mistakes and become more aggressive fighters against the British.

#4: Foreign Allies

 Without the assistance of France, the German Prussians, and the Spanish, America may not have won the war.

Treaty of Paris - 1783

- When the war ended, Benjamin Franklin and John Adams went to Paris to sign the peace agreement.
- Here are the important facts about the Treaty of Paris:
 - 1. England recognized America's victory and independence.
 - 2. England acknowledged that America was now it's own nation.
 - 3. England and America agreed to the new land boundaries in North America (on the next slide).
 - 4. England returned land to the Spanish that they took during the French & Indian War.
- The war officially ended on April 15, 1783 (almost 8 years to the day when the "shot heard round the world" started it).



The Treaty of Paris in 1783 granted the United States *independence* from Britain and all lands east of the Mississippi River.
